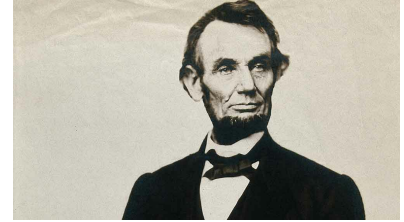

Having led the country during the turbulence of the Civil War, _Abraham Lincoln_ played an important and highly respected role in US history.



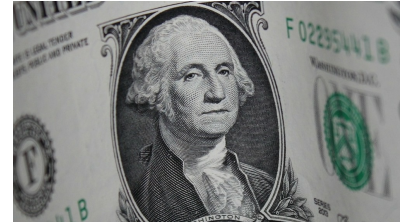

George Washington was the appointed commander of the Continental Army during the Revolutionary War.



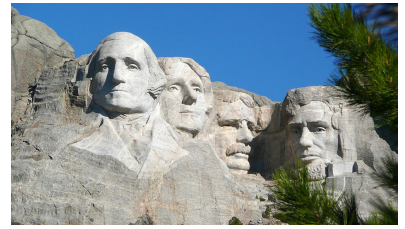

Every four years, Americans vote to choose a new _president_ to lead the United States.



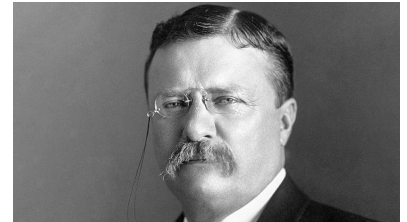

As a result of the assassination of William McKinley, _Theodore Roosevelt_ became the 26th president of the United States.



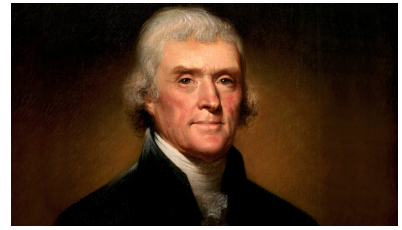
