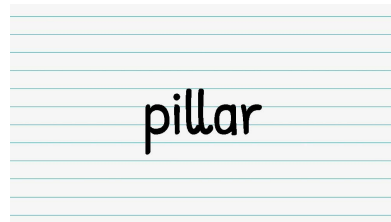

Ms. Flint was such a _pillar_ of the school community that they named the computer lab after her when she retired.



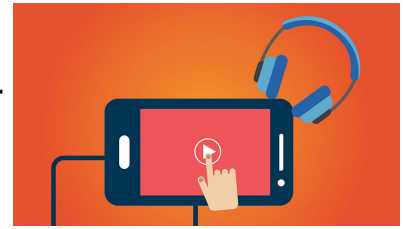
