during a war, especially World War II, a type of prison in which a large number of persecuted people are forced to live in very bad conditions. Sometimes they are forced to work and are killed.

After becoming chancellor of Germany, Hitler set up _concentration camps_ to imprison people who were considered "racially undesirable."

a disease spread by ticks, fleas, mice and rats that causes headache, fever, and rash. It causes many deaths during times of war and famine.
