Chinese philosopher and legal theorist who died in 233 BCE.

The strict laws of Legalism enacted during the Qin dynasty were developed by the Chinese philosopher _Han Fei-tzu_.

inactive]>

not operating.

That volcano is _inactive_ now, so it isn't expected to erupt.

Antonyms: active
