Antonyms: liberate

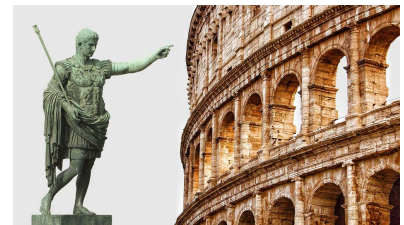

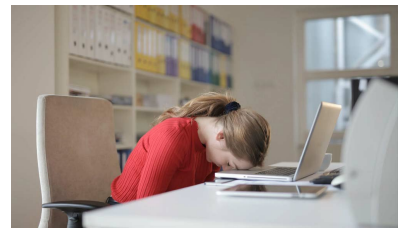
