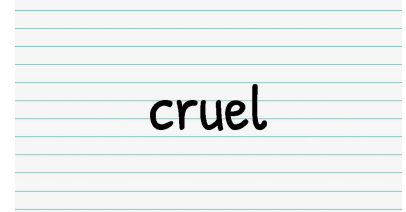
cruel]>

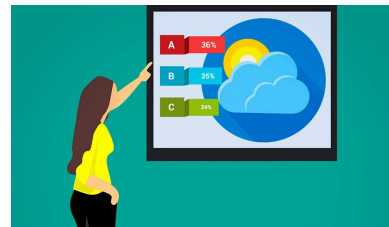
