Antonyms: oppose

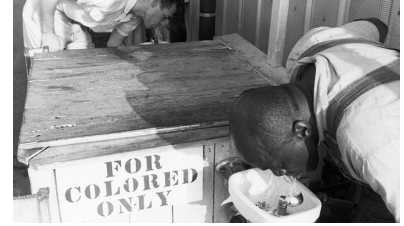
segregation]>
