Machu Picchu is an extraordinary city from the civilization of the _Inca_ in Peru.



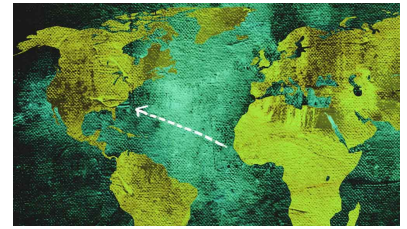

The last emperor of the Aztec civilization, _Montezuma II_, ruled the Aztecs from 1502-1520.



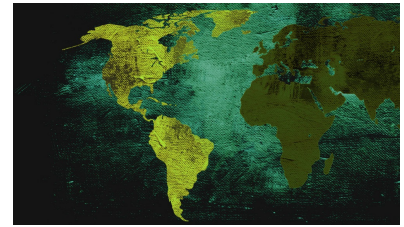

triangular trade]>

a trade route in the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries that involved shipping goods from Britain to West Africa to be exchanged for slaves. These slaves were then shipped to the West Indies and exchanged for sugar, rum, and other commodities. Those commodities were then shipped back to Britain.

During the 18th and 19th centuries, Britain, West Africa and the West Indies were involved in a _triangular trade_. Goods were shipped from Britain to West Africa, where they were exchanged for slaves that were then shipped to the West Indies and exchanged for sugar, rum, and other commodities that were then sent back to Britain.
