

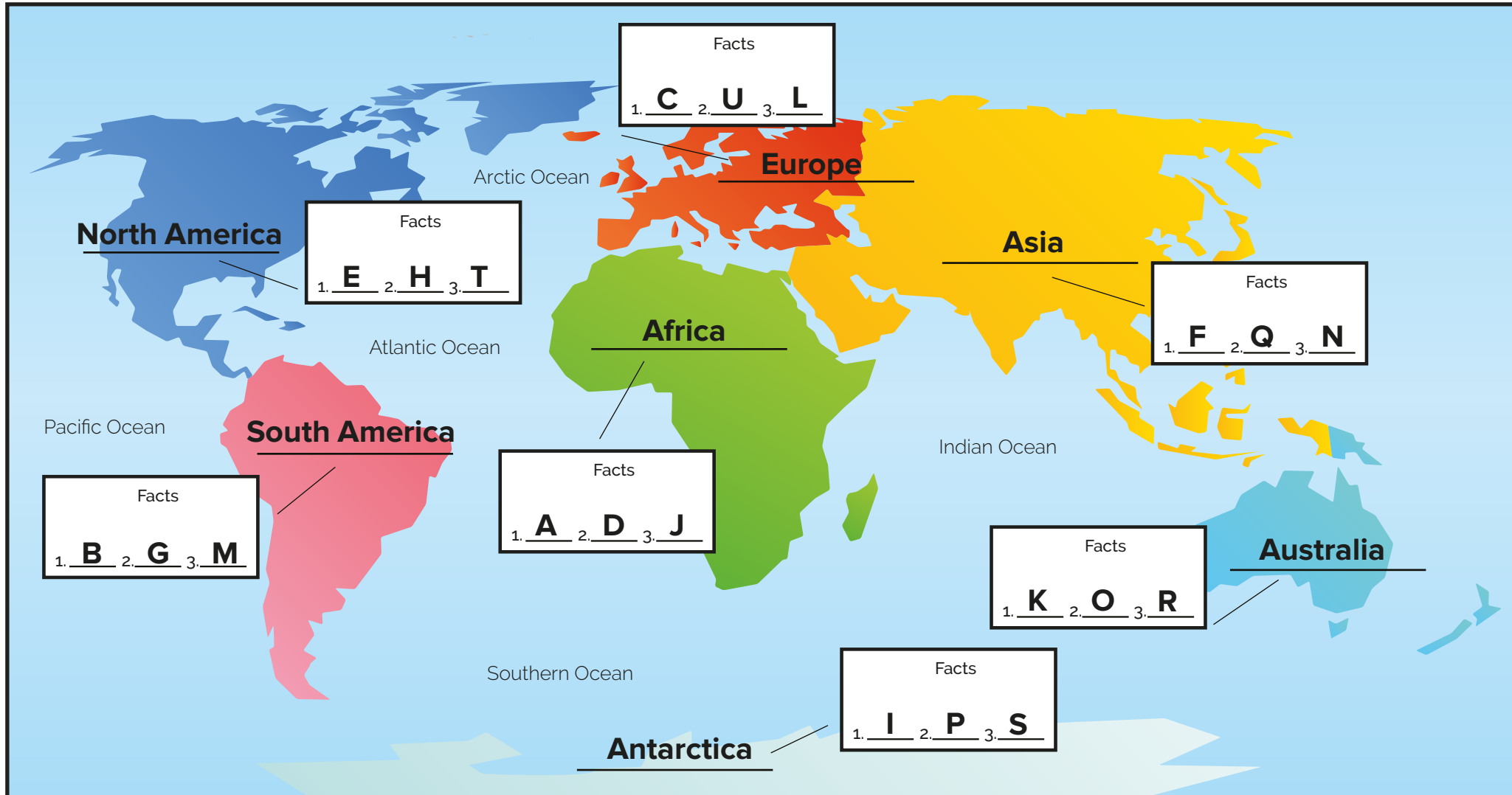

- E.** This continent includes the countries of Belize, Guatemala, Greenland and Canada.
- F.** This is the biggest continent.
- G.** This continent is bordered by the Pacific Ocean to the west, the Atlantic Ocean to the east, and North America to the north.
- H.** Central America is part of this continent.
- I.** This continent includes the South Pole.
- J.** Countries on this continent include Egypt, Nigeria, Tanzania and Rwanda.
- K.** This continent is also a country.
- L.** Countries in this continent include England, Spain, Italy, Germany and Norway.
- M.** Spanish, Portuguese, English, French and Quechua are spoken in countries of this continent.
