

FACT LIST

- **A.** This is the second largest continent.
- **B.** This continent contains the countries of Bolivia, Brazil, Chile and Guyana.
- C. This continent shares a landmass with Asia.
- **D.** The Sahara Desert covers almost one-third of this continent.
- **E.** This continent includes the countries of Belize, Guatemala, Greenland and Canada.
- **F.** This is the biggest continent.
- **G.** This continent is bordered by the Pacific Ocean to the west, the Atlantic Ocean to the east, and North America to the north.
- **H.** Central America is part of this continent.
- I. This continent includes the South Pole.
- **J.** Countries on this continent include Egypt, Nigeria, Tanzania and Rwanda.
- **K.** This continent is also a country.

- **L.** Countries in this continent include England, Spain, Italy, Germany and Norway.
- **M.** Spanish, Portuguese, English, French and Quechua are spoken in countries of this continent.
- **N.** Malaysia, Vietnam, Lebanon and Syria are part of this continent.
- O. This continent contains a remote area called the "outback."
- **P.** You can find penguins and seals (but no human residents) on this continent.
- **Q.** Over 4 billion people live on this continent.
- **R.** Cities on this continent include Sydney Melbourne and Brisbane.
- **S.** This continent has no countries.
- **T.** The Panama Canal makes it possible for ships to travel between this continent and South America.
