Face the grim problem of existence."

Of mankind's goods have failed...The money changers

Have fled from their high seats" in society.

"We may now restore...ancient truths...more noble than...profit," see

"Happiness lies not in the mere possession of money

It lies in the joy of achievement; in the thrill of creative effort.

The joy and moral stimulation

Of work no longer must be forgotten in the...chase of...profits...

"Restoration calls...for" more than "changes in ethics."

"This nation asks for action, and action now."

"Our greatest primary task is

to put people to work." Here's how:

"Government recruiting...treating the task as we would...war."

And "Through this employment" accomplish more

"Greatly needed projects to stimulate" the nation.

Also "we must recognize the overbalance of population

In our industrial centers" and through "redistribution"

Provide relief for farmers, and "raise" their "product" "values."
