After the Mexican Revolution, _Diego Rivera_ and other artists were hired to paint murals across the country.



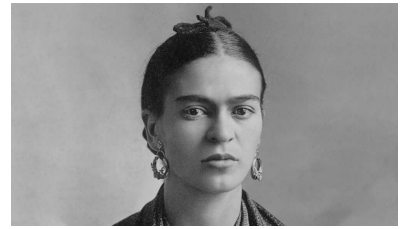

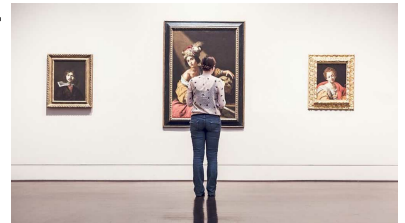

an element that repeats in a work of art, literature, music, etc.

After the fourth time a butterfly appeared in the book, it became clear it was a _motif_ and had to mean something.

polio]>

a serious disease caused by a virus and especially affecting young children. It can cause paralysis and permanent muscle weakness.

Former President Franklin Delano Roosevelt was diagnosed with _polio_ in 1921, well before the vaccine to prevent the virus became widely available.

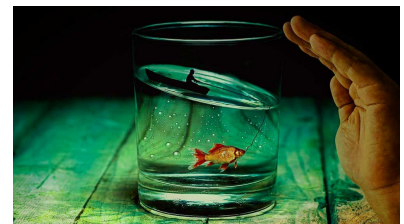

Surrealism explores oddities of the mind through art, and the results can be downright bizarre.



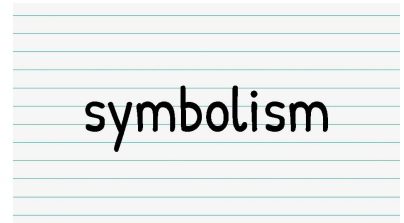
