He grew up on a large \_plantation\_ where cotton was grown.



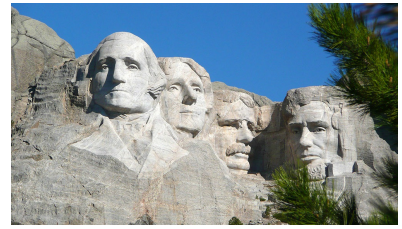
