A bladesmith can _forge_ a knife out of a piece of steel.



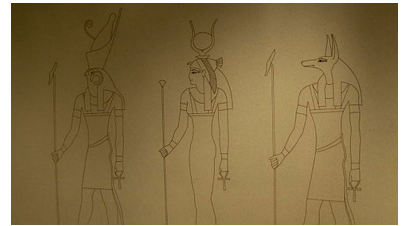

The sea god holds a _trident_ as a symbol of his power and force.



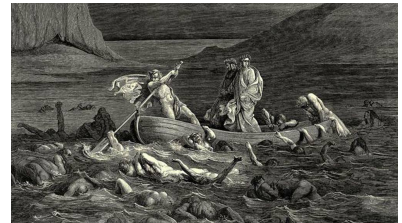
