

Synonyms: representative government





a group of representatives from each nation of the Haudenosaunee Confederacy who were selected to make laws and rules for the Haudenosaunee people.

The _Great Council of 50 Sachems_ was made up of representatives from each of the six nations in the Haudenosaunee Confederacy.
