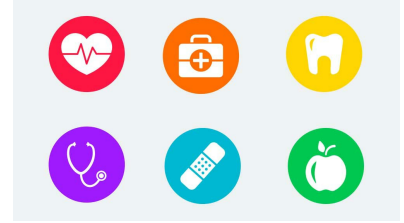

the maintaining and improvement of physical, mental and public health, especially including the efforts and services involved in providing medical care.

The cost of his medicine was covered by his _health care_ plan.

harm or damage done to a person or animal's body.

an agreement with a company in which a person pays the company a regular sum of money and the company agrees to cover the cost if a certain event occurs, such as illness or damage to property.

My travel _insurance_ covered the expenses I would have had to pay when I needed to cancel my flight.



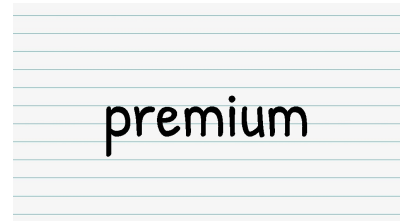

the amount paid regularly by the customer for an insurance policy

Since our company pays for our health insurance in full now, we don't have to pay the _premium_ anymore.

keeping something bad from happening.

Tammy, who studied public health, knows the best methods for sanitation and disease _prevention_ in crowded cities.

Synonyms: avoidance, prohibition

single-payer]>

a national health insurance system in which a single public agency organizes and pays for healthcare for all individuals.

Finland has _single-payer_ health insurance, so going to the doctor is free!

tax]>

a sum of money that people and businesses have to pay the government in return for public services.

New York adds a 9% tax to things we buy, which helps pay for schools and other services.

Synonyms: levy, tariff, toll

Tax can also be used as a verb, like in this sentence: "What did they tax you for that purchase?"

Clean water and food are _universal_ needs.



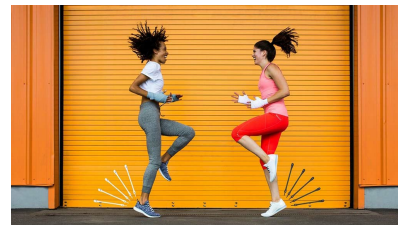
