Emancipation Proclamation]>

a presidential proclamation and executive order made by President Lincoln on January 1, 1863. It freed all the slaves in the Confederate States and territories.

President Lincoln issued the _Emancipation Proclamation_ in 1863. The act freed all the slaves living in Confederate states not yet under Union control during the Civil War.
