The prophet \_Muhammad\_ started Islam around 610 in Mecca, a holy city in present-day Saudi Arabia.



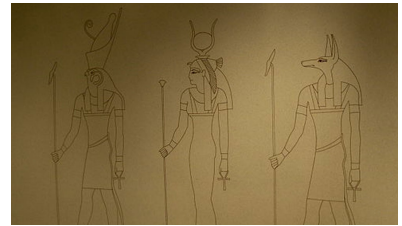

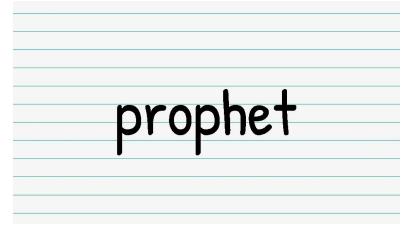
