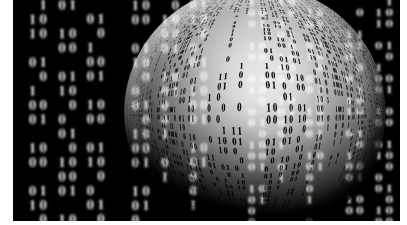

Synonyms: cord, wire



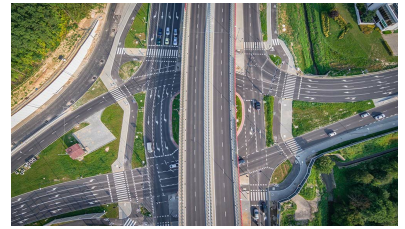

The new transportation _infrastructure_ allows people to travel through the city quickly and efficiently.



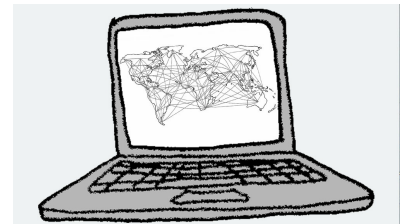

Edna works for an _internet service provider_, a company that provides internet access to customers for a fee.



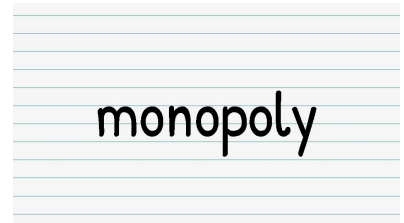

the idea or rule that internet service providers (ISPs) should treat all online content equally without blocking or slowing down specific websites on purpose or letting companies pay for better treatment.
