

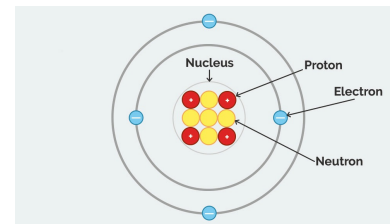

Antonyms: destroy, demolish



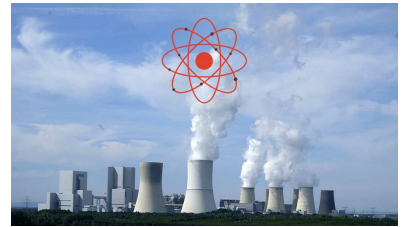

a rapid increase in the number or amount of something.

The leaders agreed that continued weapon _proliferation_ is dangerous, so they promised to decrease their stashes.

Synonyms: expansion

an official agreement between two or more countries or groups.
