

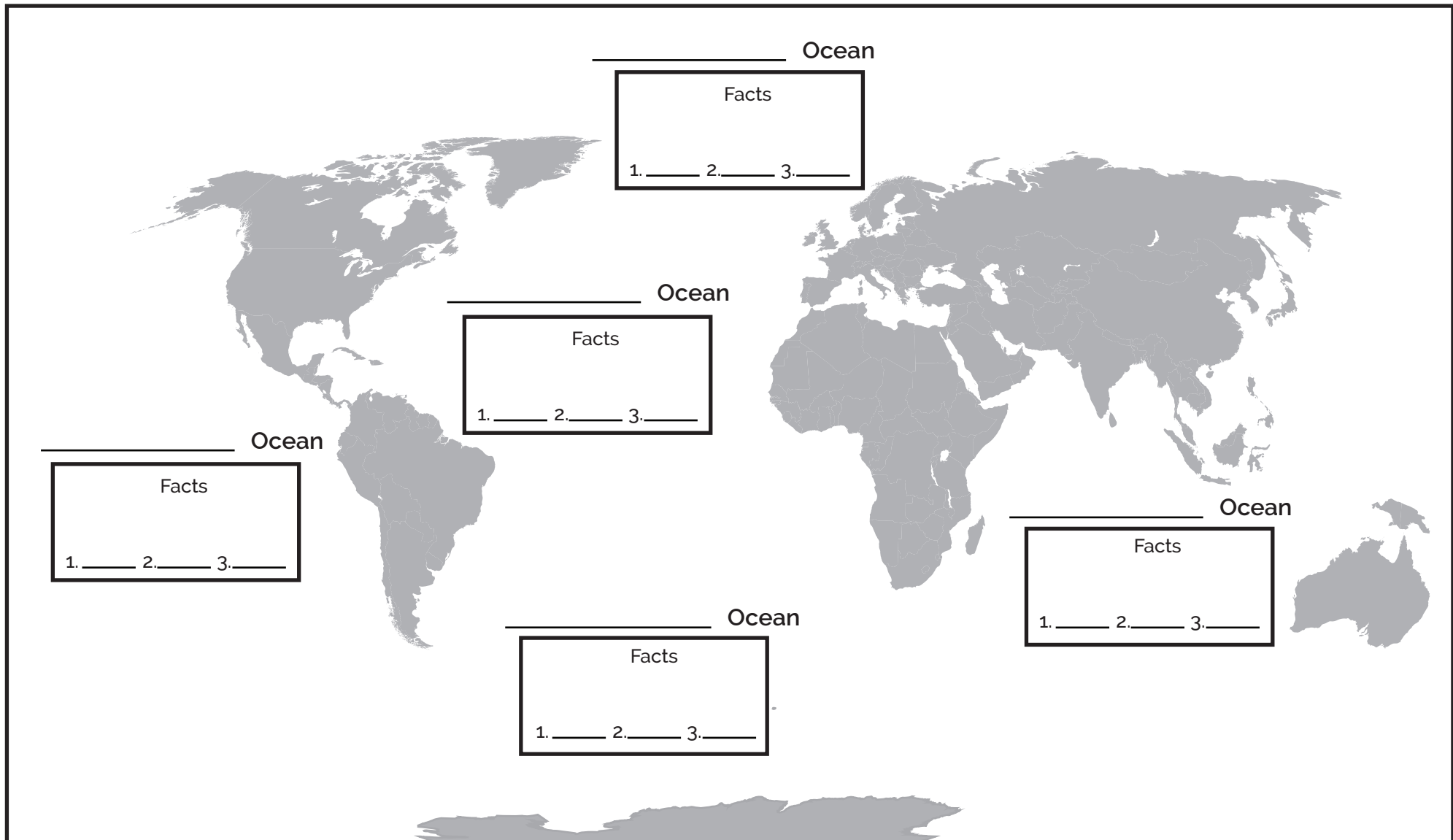

- C** This is the smallest ocean.
- D** This ocean is associated with monsoons.
- E** The Gulf Stream is a strong current in this ocean.
- F** This ocean was named in the year 2000.
- G** This ocean contains polynas like North Water. Polynas are areas of water that do not freeze but are surrounded by sea ice.
- H** This ocean contains more than 25,000 islands.
- I** This ocean contains important trade routes for oil.
- J** The major port cities of this ocean include: Singapore, Mumbai (India), Aden (Yemen), Durban (South Africa), Jakarta (Indonesia), and Muscat (Oman).
- K** This ocean contains the southernmost water on Earth.
- L** This ocean separates North America from Europe and South America from Africa.
- M** This ocean surrounds Antarctica.
