

- **A** This ocean covers more than 30% of the earth's surface.
- **B** The longest mountain range on Earth is located on the floor of this ocean.
- **C** This is the smallest ocean.
- **D** This ocean is associated with monsoons.
- **E** The Gulf Stream is a strong current in this ocean.
- **F** This ocean was named in the year 2000.
- This ocean contains polynas like North Water. Polynas are areas of water that do not freeze but are surrounded by sea ice.
- **H** This ocean contains more than 25,000 islands.
- I This ocean contains important trade routes for oil.
- The major port cities of this ocean include: Singapore, Mumbai (India), Aden (Yemen), Durban (South Africa), Jakarta (Indonesia), and Muscat (Oman).
- K This ocean contains the southernmost water on Earth.
- **L** This ocean separates North America from Europe and South America from Africa.
- **M** This ocean surrounds Antarctica.
- **N** This ocean is bordered by Greenland, Canada, Alaska, Russia, and Norway.
- **O** The deepest known place on Earth is located in a trench in this ocean.
