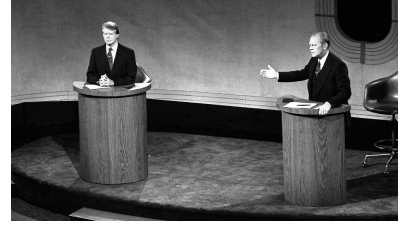
Political Parties - Vocab Cards
