When you are accused of a crime you have the right to legal _counsel_, even if you can't afford to pay a lawyer.

a formal statement of charges in a criminal case.



The _jury_ returned from deliberation with their verdict.





a written document that orders someone to appear in court to provide evidence.

Each witness received a written _subpoena_ that ordered them to appear in court during the trial.

to declare something has happened, usually in court, while promising you are telling the truth.

When people _testify_ under oath, they promise to tell the truth as they describe events they witnessed.

trial]>

a formal examination of facts and evidence by a judge and usually a jury to determine if someone accused of wrongdoing is guilty or not guilty.
