

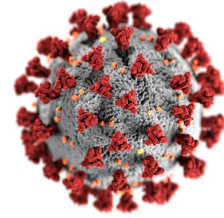

In 2019, a new _coronavirus_ was identified. It closely resembled other members of the family of virus that can sometimes sicken humans.



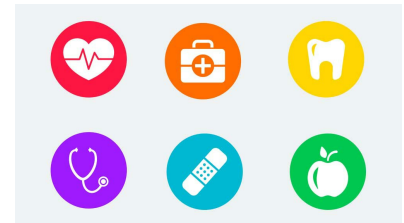

Clean water is important to _public health_. Diseases can spread through cities due to unclean water.



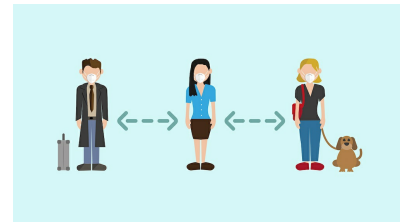

When a disease begins to spread, it is important to practice _social distancing_ to help reduce person to person infection.



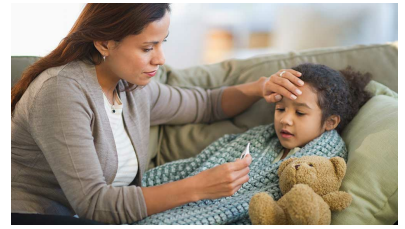
