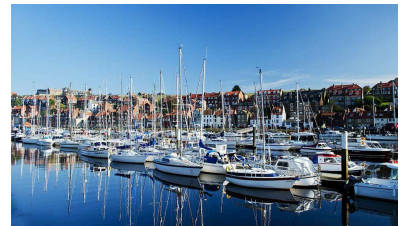

Some people think flowers have different meanings. For instance, red roses are said to \_represent\_ love.



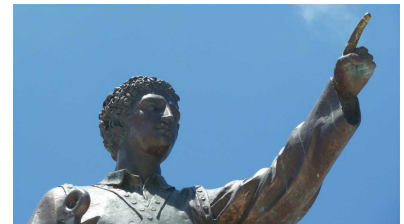
