Anti-federalist]>


an early US political position that opposed a strong central government and wanted more power in the states.

Patrick Henry, an Anti-federalist, feared what might result from an overly powerful central government.

Bill of Rights]>

the first ten amendments to the US Constitution, ratified in 1791 and guaranteeing fundamental rights to the people of the United States.

The amendments in the Bill of Rights guarantee rights like freedom of speech and worship.



constitution]>

the document that describes the principles and laws of a country, state, or organization.

When questions arise, the Supreme Court is tasked with interpreting the US Constitution and determining what the basic laws of the country express.
