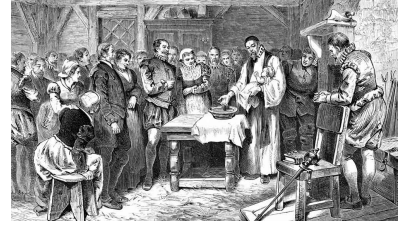
Thanksgiving - Vocab Cards

Synonyms: collect



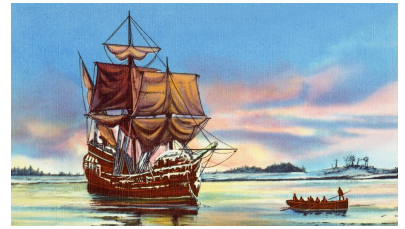

Squanto]>

a member of the Pawtuxet tribe in present-day New England. He acted as an interpreter and guide for the Pilgrims in the early 1620s. He died in 1622.
