I love today's jazz musicians, but I love the classic jazz singers most of all. _Billie Holiday_ is my favorite.



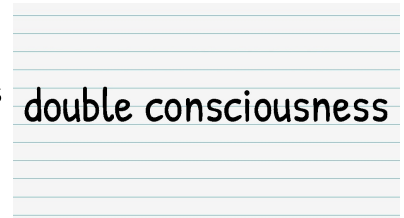

a concept, coined by W.E.B. Du Bois in 1903, that describes a minority individual feeling as though their identity is divided into several parts, making it difficult or impossible to have one unified identity, because of a prejudiced society. In relation to race in the US, Du Bois said that Black Americans are forced to view themselves through the eyes of a racist society.

W.E.B. Du Bois' theory of _double consciousness_ noted the identity struggles of many African Americans.

Great Migration]>

the relocation of millions of African Americans from the rural South to northern and western cities in the US from 1910 to 1970. Many moved to escape Southern poverty and segregationist laws following the outbreak of World War I.

During the _Great Migration_, about six million African Americans moved out of the South in search of opportunities in the North and West.

a section of northern Manhattan in New York City, known since the 1920s as a hub for African-American culture.
