Patrick Henry, an \_Anti-federalist\_, feared what might result from an overly powerful central government.



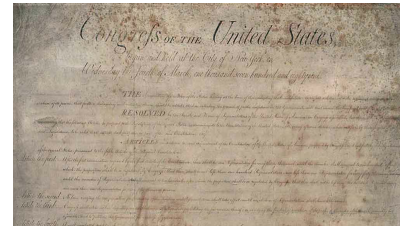

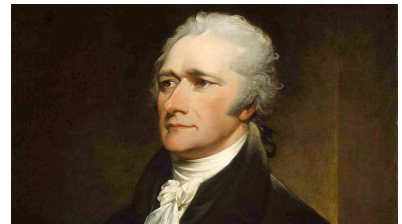
