The strict government _censored_ the media, so people never knew the truth about current events.

unfair or prejudiced treatment of a person or group.

The employees had a protest; they felt that the company was practicing _discrimination_—treating people unfairly based on their race and religion.

the act, process, or policy of combining groups of people who had previously been separated due to race, religion, etc.

The Supreme Court's landmark decision in *Brown v. Board of Education* in 1954 called for the _integration_ of public schools, which had been segregated by race for many years.
