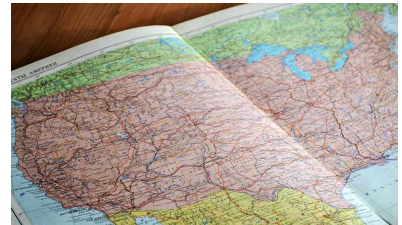

Synonyms: bargaining, dialogue, mediation



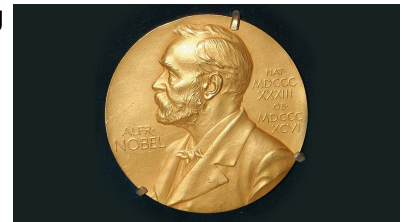

a group of nations formed in 1945 meant to help improve situations around the world.

a United Nations program that provides assistance to children and women in developing countries.

World War II]>

My grandfather fought in _World War II_ and was on one of the boats that landed on the beaches of Normandy, France.
