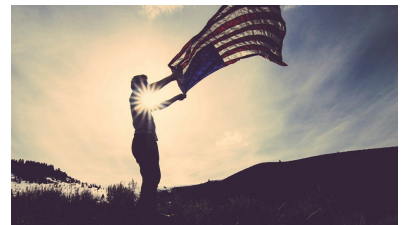

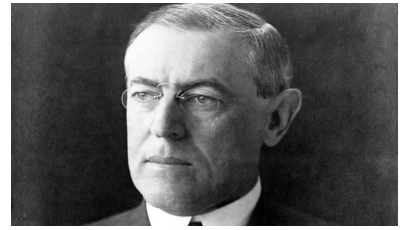

## World War I ]>

the war fought between the **Allies (mainly France, Great Britain and the United States)** and the **Central Powers (mainly Germany and Austria-Hungary)** from **1914 to 1918**. It ended with the defeat of the **Central Powers**.

By the time \_World War I\_ ended with Germany and Austria-Hungary's defeat, over 38 million Americans and Europeans had died.
