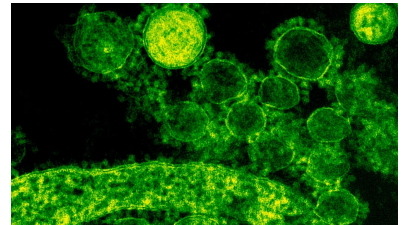
infected]>

When I swim laps, I turn my head to the side to _inhale_.



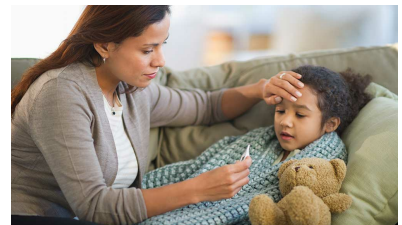
