**an agreement between people, groups, or nations to work together toward a common goal.**

Britain, France, Russia and Italy formed an \_alliance\_ against the Central Powers during World War I.

**an agreement by all sides in a war to stop fighting.**

World War I is often referred to as the \_Great War\_. During this four-year period, the Allies and the Central Powers were engaged in different forms of brutal combat.

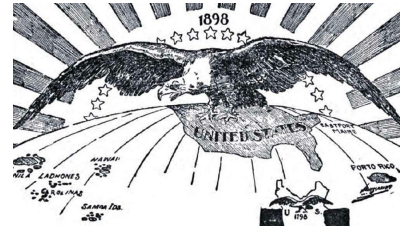

**a system or policy of one country taking control of other countries using force and diplomacy.**

**policy or belief in a strong military force.**

**pride and loyalty to one's nation; in its extreme form, a belief that one's nation should be separate from or is more important than others.**

**false or biased information that is used to make the general public feel a certain way about a political issue or situation.**

**a set amount of food or supplies given out, especially during war.**
